- One Fat Quarter of background fabric
- ½ yard of fabric for the border (for a pillow or wall hanging)
- SF101 or a Woven Fusible Interfacing to fuse on the background fabric
- Stabilizers Medium to Heavy Cutaway OR 2 layers of No-Show Mesh And Water Soluble (fabric type) enough for 2 layers in the 4 x 4 hoop
- Clean Toothbrush
- Sticky Roller
- Embroidery Threads: Dark Brown, Medium Brown, Lt Brown or Beige (for trunk), Green of choice (for tree), and Yellow (for star)

Garland and Ornaments Thread Colors: Examples – blue, red, yellow, gold, purple, white, silver

- Sewing thread for construction
- USB Memory Stick with the designs you purchased from A Stitch In Time Designs
- One Pre-wound White Bobbin and 4 empty bobbins
- Needle Size 11/75 OR 12/80 Embroidery
- Small Sharp Scissors for snipping the bobbin thread to create the fringe.
- Rotary Cutter
- 3" x 18" or larger quilters ruler

Equipment

- Embroidery Machine and Electric Cord
- Embroidery Unit
- Embroidery Foot and Zigzag foot with Ankle
- Embroidery Hoops: 4x4 and 5x7 (Regular hoop that came with your machine)
- Accessory Tray



Cutting Instructions For Wall Hanging

- 1. Cut Center fabric 9 x 13. Fuse woven interfacing to the wrong side of the center fabric.
- 2. Cut four 2 ½" x 11" strips for the borders.
- 3. Cut one 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 10" strip for the hanger sleeve.
- 4. Cut two 12" x 15" for the backing. Press wrong sides together to measure 12" x 7 1/2".
