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Celebrating 250 Year Wallhanging Supply List

In celebrating the 250 years of America's independence, A Stitch in Time Designs has created two sizes of mini quilts 6x10 and 7x12 (Mini Quilt 2). The 6x10 design has two options, Option 1 has a satin stitch type on the fireworks along with a couple of stars at the top and Option 2 has sketched type fireworks at the top. The Mini Quilt 2 (7x12) has Option 1 only.

Both sizes are embroidered entirely in the hoop and features iridescent mylar in between the stitching on the 250 which gives it a beautiful sparkly effect. The piece of mylar will be supplied for each student at the time of class. An optional border with mitered corners will be explained in class.

When registering for class you can get a 30% discount code from Tracy to purchase one or both of the design collections: ITH 250 Mini Quilt and ITH 250 Mini Quilt 2. A Stitch In Time Embroidery

You Will Need – Please carefully read and check the list below

- Purchase one or both of the design collections: ITH 250 Mini Quilt, ITH 250 Mini Quilt 2 from A Stitch in Time Designs. See website link above.
- Front and Back Fabric in a light blue.
Cut two pieces 9" W by 14" tall (this will be for the 6x10 or 7x12 size)
- Hanger Fabric on top cut 6.75" by 4" tall
Note: Spray starch fabric before cutting the above fabrics
- Batting cut one piece 6.75 wide by 11.25" tall
- Mylar will be supplied for each student at the time of class.
- Optional Border: ½ yard of fabric print
Cut 2 strips selvedge to selvedge 3" wide
Cut 2 backs 12" W by 21" Tall
Sewing Thread for construction
- Stabilizer – Medium or Heavy weight Cutaway
- Embroidery Threads: Red, White, Royal Blue, Dark Blue (somewhat darker than the royal blue), Light Blue to match the background quilting of the fabric.
- USB Memory Stick with the designs that are purchased from A Stitch in Time Designs.
- One Pre-wound White Bobbins
- Needle Size 11/75 Embroidery
- Scissors for snipping threads
- Fabric Scissors
- Straight pins or Wonder Clips (for optional added borders)



- Thread Stand if using larger cones of thread

Equipment

- Embroidery Machine and Electric Cord
- Embroidery Unit
- Embroidery foot
- Embroidery Hoops: 6x10, 7x12 or 8x12 (Regular hoop that came with your machine **OR** a magnetic hoop)
