

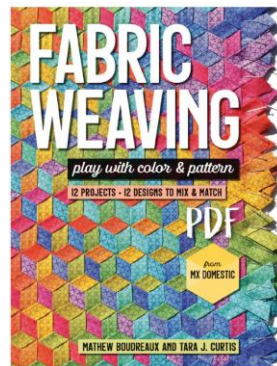
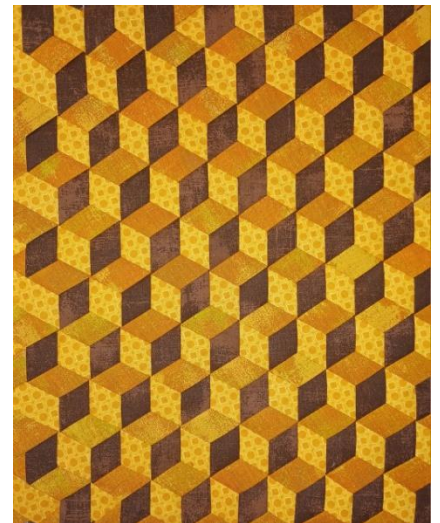

Fabric Weaving Supply List
May 20 or 22, 2026, 10 am – 1 pm
Instructor: Tracy Dally

We will be making strips out of fabric, preparing the Foam Board surface for weaving and how to weave a triaxial block layout pattern. This gives a great opportunity to use up scraps or design a fabric for a special project. The fabric can be used for pillows, bags, placemats, totes, zipper pouches, yoke for clothing, potholders and so much more.

You Will Need – Please carefully read and check the list below. No machine needed.

- *Fabric* - 100% cotton fabric that reads solid ½ yard of 3 different colors – light, medium, and dark (refer to photos)
- Fusible Interfacing (Ex. Shape Flex SF101)
- Heavy Spray Starch
- Bias Tape Maker – Size ¾” (Available at SWI)
- Foam Board 11” x 14” (Purchase at Hobby Lobby)
- Magic Pins (Appliqué is my favorite)
OR Glass Head Pins (Available at SWI))
- Rotary Cutter (Available at SWI)
- Quilter’s Ruler (Available at SWI) 3”x 18 or larger
- Wefty Weaving Tool (Purchase online – Mx Domestic or Amazon) See Photo Below
- Fabric Weaving play with color & pattern, from Mx Domestic, by Mathew Bourdreaux and Tara J. Curtis (Purchase online – Mx Domestic or Amazon) See Below - Very Helpful
- Purple Thang (Available at SWI)
- Seam Ripper – For feeding the strips through the bias tape maker
- Travel Iron
- Ironing Board or Mat
- Paper Tape (Available at SWI) or 1-inch masking or painter’s tape
- Fabric Scissors (Available at SWI)



Preparation – By preparing the strips prior to class, it saves time to learn the triaxial weaving pattern.

1. Starch all fabric before cutting.
2. Cut strips $\frac{3}{4}$ " finished: Cut (6) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " by width of fabric for each color. Use the $\frac{3}{4}$ " Bias Tape Maker.
3. Using the iron and iron board or mat, insert the strip through the bias tape maker using the seam ripper to help get it started. 4. Place the strips on a hanger to prevent folds.
5. The Foam Board will be prepared in class, pinning and weaving the strips and preparing the fabric to be removed from the Foam Board.

I look forward to showing you this weaving technique and hope you like creating it as much as I do.
