Join the fun embroidering this Fancy Fill Dresden Plate design that can be used in many different projects, comes in three sizes and two color order options. The designs can be used to make many types of projects: potholders, candle mats, pillows, table runners, tote bags, quilts, etc. You will receive six complimentary designs plus two bonus designs, \$24 value.

You Will Need – Please carefully read and check the list below

- Fabric see below for the particular project
Note: Spray starch fabric before cutting the fabrics
- Stabilizer – Medium or Heavy weight Cutaway (Not No-Show Mesh)
- Embroidery Thread Options: Two colors one variegated and a complimentary solid color (refer to the table runner). **OR** Six colors of choice for a holiday in mind (Ex. Fall, Christmas). **OR** Six colors in the same family from light to dark.
- USB Memory Stick for the complimentary designs to be transferred to at the time of class. (Value \$24)
- Pre-wound White Bobbins
- Needle Size 11/75 Embroidery
- Scissors for snipping threads
- Rotary Cutter
- Straight pins OR Safety Pins
- Thread Stand if using larger cones of thread

Equipment

- Embroidery Machine and Electric Cord
- Embroidery Unit
- Embroidery foot
- Embroidery Hoops: 6x10 or Larger (Regular hoop that came with your machine **OR** a magnetic hoop) Bring all hoops just in case.

Project Fabric Information

Round Mats 6-inch

1/3 yard of solid fabric, 1/3 yard of fusible fleece, **6x10 Hoop**

1. Cut one 10" x 13" for front. Cut two 9" x 11" for back.

2. Press the two 9" x 11", wrong sides together to measure 9" x 5 1/2"



Pillow – Fits 18" x 18

Fabric: 18" x 18" for center, 1/8 yard for inner border, 3/4 yard for outer border, **9 1/2" square hoop**
OR 9 1/2" x 14" hoop

1. Cut one 18" x 18" for center
2. Cut two 1 1/2" x width of fabric inner border.
3. Cut two 3" x width of fabric outer border.
4. Cut two 19" x 22" for backing. Press in half wrong sides together to measure 19" x 11"

Table Runner

Fabric: 1/3 yard of center fabric, 1/2 yard of sashing and borders, 1/2 yard of backing fabric, 1/4 yd for binding, 1/2 yard of batting, **8" x 12" Hoop**

1. Cut three 12" squares for center fabric.
2. Cut four 3" x width of fabric for sashing and borders.
3. Cut backing 18" x width of fabric.
4. Cut batting the same size as the backing fabric.
5. Cut three strips 2 1/2 - 3" wide for binding.
